

Tributes to Bharata Ratna Dr A P J Abdul Kalam on his death anniversary



Inspiring incidents from life of Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam

No adjectives are enough to highlight the exemplary contribution of Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam to India's space and defence programs. And no adjectives are enough to highlight the humility and the generosity of India's Missile Man who has won every Indian's heart. Fittingly known as the People's President, these rare stories about Dr. Kalam will only deepen the respect you have for this legend. Read on.

1. Once, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam rejected the suggestion to put broken glass on the wall of a building that needed protection. Why? Because broken glass would be harmful for birds!



This happened when Dr. Kalam was with the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and his team was discussing options to secure the perimeter of a building that needed protection. Dr. Kalam reportedly said: "If we do that, birds will not be able to perch on the wall."

2. When youngsters & teenagers requested a meeting with President Kalam, the President not only obliged and gave the kids his precious time, but he also listened carefully to the ideas the kids had!

As President, often Dr. Kalam's office would receive requests from youngsters for a meeting with the country's first citizen. Not only would Dr. Kalam meet the kids in his personal chambers at the Rashtrapati Bhavan, but he would also give them his precious time, "listen" to their ideas and provide feedback to the kids. On occasions, the President would follow up with such kids asking about the status of the ideas they discussed!



3. Soon after it was declared that Dr. Kalam would be the next President, he visited a modest school to deliver a speech. His

security detail was minimal, and he didn't mind taking control of the situation when the power went off.

Speaking to around 400 students, Dr. Kalam ensured the power cut didn't cause any interruption. He walked right in the middle of the crowd and asked the students to surround him. He then spoke to 400 students with his bare voice and delivered, like always, an inspiring keynote.


4. President Kalam has given up all his life savings and salaries to a trust he founded named PURA (Providing Urban Amenities to Rural Areas).



The government takes care of the President of India as well as of all the former presidents. Knowing this, Dr. Kalam during his tenure as President decided to give away all his wealth and life savings towards a fund that works towards providing urban amenities to rural population. Apparently, Dr. Kalam called up Dr. Verghese Kurien, the founder of Amul, and asked: "Now that I have become the President of India, the government is going to look after me till I am living; so what can I do with my savings and salary?"

5. President Kalam is known to write his own thank you cards.

As humble and generous the man is, President Kalam is known to sign his own thank you cards. One instance is when Quora user Naman Narain drew a sketch of Dr. Kalam and sent it to the President. To his surprise, the President sent him a thank you card, with a short handwritten message and personalised with his signature.



6. Supposed to attend a college event as the Chief Guest, APJ once surprised the students of the event's organising committee by visiting them late in the night.

Once, Dr. Kalam was to be a Chief Guest at a college event. He wasn't the President at the time, but held a significant office at the DRDO and was one of the key advisors to the government. Curious to see the kids prep up for a big event, Kalam decided to pay a visit to the venue. He came in a jeep, without any security, and talked to the students present at the venue. He said he wanted to meet the "real hardworking people".

7. Dr. Kalam is so humble he wouldn't mind going to an event a little late for the sake of letting his fans take pictures with him!



Dr. Kalam was the Chief Guest at an event at IIM Ahmedabad recently. Prior to the event, he was lunching with a class of around sixty students. At the end of the lunch, the students wanted each a photo with the former President.

Citing the delay, the event organiser tried to hush off the students; but to everyone's surprise Dr. Kalam asked the organiser to calm down and said that he won't leave the place until every person who wanted a picture with him got a picture!

8. Once during an event, Dr. Kalam refused to sit on a chair that was designated for him – because the chair was larger in size than the other chairs!

At a recent convocation of IIT-Varanasi, Dr. Kalam was the Chief Guest. There were five chairs on the stage, the centre one being for Dr. Kalam, the other four designated for the top university officials. Noticing his chair being bigger in size than the others, Dr. Kalam refused to sit on it and offered the Vice Chancellor to sit in stead. The VC couldn't, obviously. No doubt, another chair was made available immediately for the Honourable former President!

9. When a subordinate of President Kalam at DRDO couldn't take his children to an exhibition due to work pressure, Kalam

surprised his subordinate and took the children in stead!

During a significant project of the DRDO, the work pressure was high. A scientist approached his boss – Dr. Kalam – and asked to leave early that day considering he had promised his children to take them to an exhibition. Kalam generously granted the permission, and the scientist got back to work. When he did, he lost the track of time and forgot to leave early. He reached home, feeling guilty, and looked for his kids, but could only find his wife. He asked for the kids, and to his surprise she told him: "your manager was here around 5:15 and he took the kids for the exhibition!"

Apparently, Dr. Kalam had been observing the scientist and noticed that he might never realise he had to go home. Feeling for the kids, he decided to take the kids in his stead. If that's not sweet, what is?

10. When he was President, Dr. Kalam took to "Yahoo! Answers" and posted a question: "What should we do to free our planet from terrorism?"

And when he did, people like Sri Sri Ravishankar, Kiran Bedi, Leander Paes and the who's who of India and the world turned to Yahoo! to answer his question! Here's the link to that question page.




11. Who did President Kalam invite as the "Presidential Guests" to Kerela's Raj Bhavan during his first visit to Kerela after becoming the President?

1. A road side cobbler, 2. Owner of a very small hotel

No kidding. As the President, Dr. Kalam was entitled to invite anyone as the "Presidential Guests" to the Raj Bhavan of Kerela during his first visit to Trivandrum. Dr. Kalam had spent a significant time as a scientist in Trivandrum and he invited a road-side cobbler – who was quite close to Dr. Kalam during his time in Kerala; and so was the owner of the small hotel where Dr. Kalam would often have his meals.

Can you imagine any other politician or a celebrity inviting a cobbler and a small business owner as their most prestigious guests?

12. And the most important story – of his contribution to India's space and defence programs:



Dr. Kalam was one of the few scientists who started working with ISRO during the agency's early years. A Church became the place of work for the handful of India's rocket scientists – including Dr. Kalam; and a nearby beach became the place where the rocket launchpad was set up. Cycles and bullock-carts were used back in the 1970s & 1980s to transport rocket parts and entire satellites, and Dr. Kalam was one of the rare few scientists who made significant contributions to India's early space program.

In fact, Dr. Kalam was the Director of the project that indigenously developed the SLV-III (Space Launch Vehicle) and also the PSLV – which is operational even today and was used in the Moon and the Mars missions. In 1980, SLV-III successfully injected the Rohini satellite into a near-Earth orbit and made India an exclusive member of the Space Club.

After working with ISRO, Dr. Kalam took up responsibilities for developing Indigenous Guided Missiles at the DRDO which led to the development of AGNI and PRITHVI missiles. He also led the Pokhran-II nuclear tests that made India a nuclear weapon state.

It is said that during Indira Gandhi's regime, Dr. Kalam was the man who convinced the Prime Minister for an advanced missile program for the country – and despite the disapproval of the Union Cabinet, PM Gandhi had secretly funded Kalam's aerospace and defence projects. And the rest, as they say, is history.

CSR spending: 16% of firms give no reason for not meeting obligations

Corporate Social Responsibility



India Inc's commitment towards corporate social responsibility remains shaky, as companies give flimsy excuses for not meeting their legally mandated obligations.

To an RTI filed by Business Line seeking information on the number of companies which have given reasons to the government for not spending on CSR, the Ministry responded by saying, "CSR expenditure of 460 listed companies, which have placed their annual reports on their websites, indicates 51 Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and 409 private sector companies together spent about ₹ 6,337.36 crore on CSR during 2014-15."

According to the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, these 460 companies have cited reasons for either not spending at all or not meeting the minimum criteria on CSR in 2014-15. The reasons included adoption of long-term CSR programmes/projects, and difficulty to find suitable implementing agency.

A CII spokesperson told Business Line, "These reasons don't seem to be genuine or bona fide. If they were serious about

spending, they would have done it. One can't buy the argument that they were unable to spend on CSR as it was the first year of implementation of CSR legislation."

CSR rules mandate that if the company fails to spend the amount, the board shall, in its report, specify the reasons for not doing so. According to the Ministry, 16 per cent of 460 companies have given no reason for not spending on their CSR obligation.

As many as 30 per cent of the companies stated 'adoption of long-term CSR programmes/projects' as the reason for not meeting their obligation. About 28 per cent expressed inability to formulate well-conceived CSR policy as it was the first year of implementation.

While 5 per cent mentioned 'budget advanced to implementing agencies', 4 per cent said there was difficulty in finding a suitable implementing agency.

There are stringent penalties for companies not disclosing their CSR spends. Companies can be fined a sum not less than ₹ 50,000 and extending up to ₹ 25 lakh.

Also company officials who are in default can face imprisonment which can extend to three years or be fined ₹ 50,000 to ₹ 5 lakh, or with both.



2,351 firms fail to respect CSR mandate

As many as 2,351 companies have no existence in corporate social responsibility endeavors, according to numbers released by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs to the Rajya Sabha.



While a total of 776 firms have engaged NGOs for implementing corporate social responsibility (CSR) activities, nearly 2400 companies chose not to spend a single penny on such tasks, Corporate Affairs Minister, Arun Jaitley said in a written reply to Rajya Sabha.

An evaluation of the CSR expenditure of 4,257 companies indicates that these firms have spent about 72 per cent of the mandated amount on CSR activities, added Jaitley. Of which, 621 firms have spent more than prescribed amount, while 400 companies spent 'exactly' the same amount as prescribed under the rules.

Further, 261 firms have spent 66-99 per cent of the their mandated CSR fund, while 624 companies spent less than 66 per cent of the prescribed amount. Jaitley noted that organising private sports tournaments and one-off activities are not permissible under, adding that a total of 967 complaints are pending before the designated courts so far.

1,900 companies spend Rs 8,029 crore towards CSR works in 2014-15:

More than 1,900 companies shelled out a total of Rs 8,029 crore towards corporate social responsibility (CSR) activities in 2014-15, the government said. Out of these companies, 116 were public sector undertakings while 1,790 were private sector entities, Minister of State for Corporate Affairs Arjun Ram Meghwal told Rajya Sabha. On whether the CSR guidelines are being followed by firms, the Minister said no violation has been noticed in case of 4,257 companies for which CSR data is available. Emphasising that monitoring of CSR is the responsibility of the board of directors of companies concerned, Meghwal said the Ministry has no role to play in this regard.



Govt asks top 50 cos to fund incubators as CSR spend

The government has asked the country's top 50 companies to fund incubators as part of their corporate social responsibility (CSR) spend, a move meant to strengthen the startup ecosystem.



Large companies have to allocate 2% of their profits towards CSR but have competing demands - from building toilets to funding education. In a letter to companies, industrial policy and promotion secretary Ramesh Abhishek has added funding existing incubators in government-recognised institutions or setting up new ones to the list, said sources. "It will help upgrade the existing ones and create linkages for new companies that entrepreneurs are setting up," said an official.

The lack of incubation facilities has been identified as a key gap in the startup ecosystem which help in providing mentorship support apart from access to networks and markets.

The government had planned to set up 35 new incubators in existing institutions, with Centre and states chipping in with 80% of the funding, while the rest coming from the private sector. An equal number is to come up in the private sector with the Centre giving 50% grant.

The government has listed 68 incubators across the country and has also asked for applications for registration of new ones.

Pema reach out to Samsung for CSR initiatives



Arunachal Pradesh Chief Minister Pema Khandu had a meeting with representatives of Samsung Electronics Deepak Bharadwaj, Vice President (Public Affairs) and Vikram Sridharan, Lead Govt Vertical regarding partnership with the state government in welfare activities under the company's CSR initiatives.

One of the best offers that came up during the discussion is the establishment of 'Samsung Digital Healthcare Centers' in the state. Under this initiative, the state government will identify three tentative hospitals in the state for setting up of high end X Ray and Ultrasound digital machines (approx cost: Rs 2.50 Crores).

These machines would be provided by Samsung Electronics under CSR. "We shall be providing you the same within this week to enable recce by your team to finalise the site for installation of the same," the Chief Minister assured the company representatives.

In another initiative – Samsung Digital Program – Samsung intends to leverage students of NIT, NERIST and Polytechnics and also unemployed computer engineers and encourage them to develop mobile applications using the Tizen OS. For this Samsung has offered to train Master Trainers in the state free of cost. In this regard, it was resolved that 'Tie ups' with Ministry of MSME and Skill Development would be explored.

Pema's pursuance for skill development and employment generation further resulted in Samsung's acceptance to extend its 'Samsung Apprentice Program' in Arunachal Pradesh. Under this programme, the Chief Minister was informed, Samsung would enroll students of ITIs and Polytechnics and offer 'On the Job training' (OJT) in its Noida Plant that will subsequently guarantee placement opportunities. When informed that Samsung has already funded smart classes in all Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNVs) in the Country to set up Smart Digital Classrooms, the Chief Minister assured that the state government will inspect these Smart Classes of JNVs in Arunachal Pradesh and send a report to the company. He, however, requested Samsung Electronics to extend the usage of these facilities to other schools in the state as well.

Dabur's new CSR campaign aims at providing motherly love to orphan girls

Dabur Amla Hair Oil, is calling mothers across India to donate 1 MASSAGE HOUR for the girls in orphanages who have never



experienced mother's love. The initiative will facilitate one special day for young orphan girls who are often given toys and books, but lack the motherly touch.

'Dulaar - Aao Banae Ek Mazboot Rishta' campaign signifies the strong bond between the mother and daughter and provides an experience of motherly love with a multitude of fun and engaging activities wherein women volunteers and girls will spend quality time together.

Speaking on the initiative, Dabur India Ltd category head-hair oils, Rajat Nanda said The act of oil champi (head massage) has been a part of our Indian tradition for years now. It not only makes hair strong but also builds the bond between a mother and daughter. There are memories, experiences associated between mother and daughter with the massage time. Taking inspiration from this, Dabur India Ltd has taken a leap in introducing its Dulaar campaign, which will help the orphan girls, experience the touch of motherly love. Through this campaign, we will reach out to the orphanages and will try to make that day the most memorable for these kids.

Dabur has already received an overwhelming response of 3,000 entries from across India through various platforms such as Facebook, Twitter and phone calls. The campaign will begin in Lucknow and will be taken to other cities.

CSR funds for providing home to homeless



Now private or public companies can put their corporate social responsibility (CSR) funds for construction of shelters for the homeless in cities. Organisations can also use their donations for the same purpose. The companies and donors will be allowed to display their names for branding on such structures.

A panel headed by Union housing minister M Venkaiah Naidu also allowed construction of multi-storied shelters for urban homeless keeping in view land constraints has also been permitted besides allowing attendants of patients to use such shelters. CCTVs are to be provided in shelters for women and children to ensure their security, the ministry said.

Government plans awards for corporate social responsibility activities:

Government plans to institute awards for corporate social responsibility (CSR) activities across sectors as part of efforts to incentivise companies to take up work towards social welfare. The Corporate Affairs Ministry, which is implementing the Companies Act, is working on the idea of having such awards. Officials said the ministry is proposing to institute the awards for CSR activities across eight sectors, including education, health and environment.



The aim is to incentivise companies to carry out more CSR works that can help in overall development activities, they added.

"We are planning to set up the awards in the current financial year," an official said. As per the plan, eight sectors will be chosen and there be three awards for each of them. One will be for public sector companies and two for private firms. The private companies will be classified on the basis of annual profit -- those having Rs 5 crore or more and entities having less than that level.

FCRA waiver for swachh bharat to attract clean foreign money:



The government wants only corporates with clean antecedents and good reputation to contribute to the Swachh Bharat drive even as it has waived the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA) provisions for Swachh Bharat Mission to allow contributions from abroad.


The home ministry has allowed exemption to the mission from the FCRA Act, 2010 for accepting foreign contribution in cash or kind with retrospective effect from April 24, 2015, with a rider that the contributors' intentions are clean.

"Due diligence will be exercised to ascertain the bona fides of the contributors prior to receiving any contributions in the field. The accounts will be compulsorily audited by CAG," the home ministry said in an order to finance ministry last month. "All foreign contributions would be received in an exclusive designated bank account only and a separate set of accounts and records in respect of foreign contributions received and utilised would be maintained," it said.

Such caution towards corporate contributions to the Swachh Bharat Mission is also evident in a revised 'framework of engagement' with PSUs and corporates prepared by the government . It said the qualifying criteria for PSUs or corporate houses to have a working arrangement with the Swachh Bharat Mission would be "clean antecedents and reputation, high credibility and reputation among people and capacity and outreach for engaging with community" - **Collected, compiled & reported by: CS B Kiran Kumar Gupta, Member - abhya Foundation**

9. Private Driving School will be identified by Cheitanyananda Ashrama Members locally and support this cause. Rs.10-12k earmarked for Training Master/School - Inaugural event on 1st week of August planned - 16th October Graduation planned.

10. Coordination Committee formed with Nine members: Nanjundeswara, Rajeswari, Madhukesh Yedyurappa, Siva Rudrappa, Shanthi, Balachandra, Bhushana & Chakrapani



11. Each of the coordination Committee members agreed to donate Rs.1000/- each for the cause initiated. Further the teams declared about Rs.45,000/- donations for the cause. Abhaya foundation will spend Rs.50,000/- towards this initiative.

12. Cheitanyananda Ashrama Trustees and Members to do the following activities immediately:

(i) Mr. Yadyurappa, Panchayat Board Member shall initiate the dialogue on the trust activities for youth empowerment at the Panchayat Meeting to be held on 25th July, 2016.

(ii) Thereafter the campaigning will be initiated by the coordination committee by way of publishing pamphlets, Banners and if possible through press and other media. Door to door campaigning is proposed during weekends by the coordination committee.






