





Guidelines needed to monitor corporates' CSR spending: Tata



Eminent business leader Ratan Tata said there should be some guidelines to monitor spending of CSR funds by corporates as there might be some companies either "wasting money" or "siphoning in some form". Tata Sons

Chairman Emeritus said CSR must come form one's heart. "I don't think you can make it (CSR) into a tax which is 2 per cent of your net profit. We don't expect that there should be a penalty (for not adhering to)," he added. "There are companies that will make great contribution to the country and there would be some companies which would be either wasting the money or siphoning in some form," Tata said at the 107th annual general meeting of Indian Merchants Chambers here. Tata also said that country's greatest weakness is inequality in enforcement of governance and called for same right to govern a billionaire and a street vendor. "I think our greatest weakness today in the country is fact that there is inequality in enforcement (of governance). It depends on who you are, what you are, what your money and value is," Tata said. "And the hope, one would have for new India would be total equality that whether you are a billionaire or a street vendor you have the same rights to be governed by law and order in the same manner." He said if the country improves on equality, then the governance will take more transparent position to just ensure that one is operating within the law of the land.

SEED Infotech to Start IICA CSR Training Programs

The Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA), an institution working under the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India, has come up with special training programs in Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) for corporate sector. IICA has partnered with SEED Infotech for offering these programs in various cities

starting with Pune. A Memorandum of Understanding to this effect was signed on 12th June 2015 by Nikhil Pant, Chief Program Officer, IICA and Narendra Barhate, CEO, SEED Infotech. Dr. Bhaskar Chatterjee, Director General and CEO of Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs, Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India graced the occasion.

Under this tie-up IICA's training programs pertaining to CSR for various levels in corporate sector shall be offered through the branches of SEED Infotech. These programs will be ideal for three different levels of management including Director, General Manager and Program Manager. The training programs will enable them to acquire skills and competencies required for the effective implementation of CSR policies and practices in accordance with the new legislation.

How FCRA norms may hurt CSR contributions of Indian companies with large foreign shareholding:

Even as the government — under a directive from the Prime Minister's Office — is stepping up scrutiny of foreign-funded non-governmental organisations (NGOs), Indian companies with large foreign shareholdings are growing



increasingly uncomfortable working in the grey area around their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) contributions.

Under FCRA, any entity with over 50% investment from foreigners, PIOs, OCIs, foreign companies or FIIs is considered a foreign source. FCRA's applicability depends on the way CSR is implemented. If a foreign source company pays NGOs to do charitable work, the NGO must have FCRA permission. If the company works directly with benefi ciaries, then no FCRA is required. The most common way in which CSR is administered in India, however, is through the company's own foundation or trust.

Aditya Birla's CSR empowering women of Sambalpur

Aditya Aluminium Company, a unit of Aditya Birla Group, has launched in Odisha's Sambalpur district a CSR initiative under which it is promoting self-help groups (SHGs) and helping rural women start ventures like phenyl production, poultry farming and tailoring.

Bibhu Mishra, COO of Aditya Aluminium, says, "We are concerned about the welfare of women from this region and by promoting the SHGs we want to imbibe a sense of entrepreneurship and independence so that they can live with pride and dignity. We have seen visible progress in this regard in Rengali block."

Sunaphula Chhuria from Dudhkabahal village of Rengali block in Odisha's Sambalpur district was a daily labourer barely scraping together enough for one square meal a day. Sunaphula and her husband are from a poor OBC community. Though both worked as daily labourers at that time, it was tough to make ends meet as there was very little money to keep them afloat, she said adding work too came off and on, sometimes in trickles, sometimes not at all.

But life changed one day for the couple and families like theirs when Sunaphula was introduced into the SHG mode of operation done by the CSR initiative in periphery development of Aditya Aluminium Company. As Sunaphula puts it, she learnt about methods and guidelines of SHG. After a few months the group has agreed to prepare phenyl and supply to companies and market nearby. The idea has created a new buzz among group members who are trained by professionals hired by company's CSR-wing.

Panel on corporate social responsibility assessment to submit report this month:

The high-level committee set up by the government to suggest measures and methodology for a proper assessment of corporate social responsibility initiatives taken by India Inc is likely to submit its final report this month.

The panel is likely to recommend setting up of a CSR data analysis platform that will take into consideration details such as funds utilised and geographical areas served, officials said. Besides, the panel is considering several other measures to keep tabs on social spending undertaken by companies indirectly through non-governmental organisations.

'50,000 BPL families in JK to get free LPG connections'

As many as 50,000 families living below the poverty line in Jammu and Kashmir will get free LPG connections under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR).

This was stated by Minister for Consumers Affairs and Public Distribution Choudhary Zulkar Ali during his surprise visit to HPCL Bottling Plant at Bari Brahmana Jammu. The minister inspected facilities and preparedness of supply at the bottling plant. The Minister said the BPL families would be exempted from depositing security money for the cylinder and regulator. "They would just have to pay the cost of the LPG," he said.

Gujarat govt to help firms use CSR funds

The government has now set up the Gujarat Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Authority to create an exclusive agency to channelise contributions to finance projects like construction of toilets and tackling malnutrition, besides several other themes.

"It is Chief Minister Anandiben Patel's idea, which has been spruced up by the official machinery," Maheshwar Sahu, who is a retired IAS officer and the chairman of the CSR Authority created in April, told Mail. "We have created this authority to facilitate



companies to channelise their mandatory two per cent earnings for social infrastructure." He says there are 14,000 companies, including some 13,500 forming the small and medium scale industrial units, which are supposed to park funds under CSR activities.

Sahu says the idea is to create a channelising body where the companies investing in CSR can donate or park their funds for effective social development initiatives of the state government. "Several companies don't know where to put their mandatory CSR funds, so our idea is to help them," Sahu said.

"So, once a company approaches us seeking guidance on where to invest, we will put it through an implementing agency at the grassroot level working on the particular subject. The companies can also directly contact the agencies, which will largely be non-government organisations (NGOs)," he says.

"We have taken up pilot projects for construction of toilets in rural and urban areas, tackling malnutrition and diagnostic healthcare," Sahu added. He said the initiative was not to put state government funds but those of the corporates into social initiatives - Compiled by CS B. Kiran Kumar, BK

abhaya submitted its suggestions on CSR Policy & Implementation



1. A State level CSR Monitoring Board comprising of eminent personalities from Government, Corporate Houses, NGOs, Professional Bodies, Tax Dept., etc., to be formed

where all the eligible NGO's undertaking the notified activities as per the CSR Rules need to be registered and the corporate houses to give the funds only to these registered NGO's for specific projects. We could have only four to five NGO's catering to only health, four to five NGOs only dealing with primary education and so on. This will ensure that the funds are spent by the corporates through the NGOs in the local area's as well as proper channelization of the funds and all round development.,

- 2. The fund which is kept aside as part of 2% of Net Profit must be spent in 3 years
- 3. Grading mechanism must be in place for the Companies who are spending CSR Funds enabling the Corporate to get grades which would play a role in getting investments/ loans for running the business as socially responsible citizen of the Country.
- 4. As of now, the provisions of Section 135 the Corporates need to either spend the monies or give reasons for not doing so, as the objective of Section 135 is to bring about social reformation for the betterment of Community, there has to be mechanism to access the genuinely of Corporate houses who are unable to spend the funds and the consequences in case if the reasons provided is not justifiable.
- 5. The Funds to be spent on CSR need to be transferred to a separate CSR account during the course of the financial year and the same to be part of the CSR policy considering the fact that CSR Funds are being spent out of NP after Tax, there should not be Tax Exemptions again on the amount spent by the Companies which would make the Companies to search for the NGOs who are having 80G/35AC exemptions as the case may be.
- 6. A professional to provide CSR Funds utilization Certificate which will be part of Annual documents of each company.
- 7. Each Company having a CSR budget of more than Rs. 5 crores to

employ a qualified professional having Masters Degree in Social Work to manage the CSR Activities of the Company under the supervision of CSR Committee headed by Independent Director.

- 8. The Companies falling under this threshold may adopt a remote village of their choice and develop it as model village in line with Prime Minister Call on Sansad Grama Yojana Scheme.
- 9. Professionals like a Company Secretary/ Chartered Accountant/ Cost Accountant need to monitor CSR Activities of the NGO's as well as the Company and review them at the Board Level.
- 10. A Secretarial Standard must be in kept in place by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, New Delhi enabling corporate houses to take the same in to consideration while implementing the policies
- 11. Corporate Houses can look at the unemployed or under employed youth in the locality where they operate and offer them free training for skill development and placement opportunity.
- 12. State / Central Government to constitute State / Central Level CSR Awards for the Companies in the country giving away the awards and by presenting the best corporate who did the community work with their funds based on parameters.
- 13. Government to notify what are all the Projects which needed to have support from Corporate Houses in the country by including them as item in the Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013.14.
- 14. The NGO's who received CSR Funds must annually file a funds utilization certificate along with a report on impact the CSR Fund created in the community.
- 15. If any Company wish to spend on CSR from their funds even if they are not coming under the provisions of Section 135, the Govt must give them special incentive or tax rebate / exemption for their good work.




abhaya providing a traditional well in deep forest for the benefit of tribals near Chippagere


they would pool money and fix motor and overhead tanker after completion of well. Together each work will happen to the benefit of more people - **abhaya TEAM**

Sevalayam, Madurai - an inspiring update



Sevalayam Campus with new look:

During the vacation, we started the renovation of Sevalayam Campus, white-washing and painting. All the works, as planned, have been completed and the Sevalayam children are enjoying the new renewed environment. We, the Sevalayam Team, is grateful for all the motivation, support and guidance extended by abhaya Foundation, Hyderabad and Corporate Donor Sify Technologies, Chennai and all others who has lend their overwhelming support for facilitating the completion of all these works successfully. Our Special thanks to Mr. Napoleon, Civil Engineer, who have reached our expectations and completed the works in a very short period.

Digital Class Room @ Sevalayam:

A Chennai based NGO named "MOTHER" which is run by a family of Vipassana Meditators, donated 3 new Computers with UPS. Already we have 3 computers of lower configuration. So, it is decided to set up a computer Centre in one of the buildings at Sevalayam. There was a need for furniture, knowing this, Ms.Subbulakshmi of VIT, Chennai has consented to

donate the same. The power wiring has to be extended to all these systems and the place in the 1st Floor where we have planned to install the Computers, do not have such provision. Hence, it is planned to be extend from the ground floor. Besides, the room does not have fans so 2 Fans are required for the benefit of both the Students and the Systems.

As of now, the systems are installed as Stand-alone and as we get stabilized, we may connect them with a network. Regarding the training to be conducted, Balakumar, JTO, BSNL has consented to extend his co-operation for deciding the syllabus, modules and faculty for conducting the courses. We have assured to pay some nominal tuition fees for the faculty and MOTHER organization has also assured to share the burden of tuition fees.



The plan is to provide training for practical programmers in the class room like DTP, Office Automation, and Accounting Software like TALLY and programming languages which would be helpful for the students in future. Additionally we are focusing on student's current curriculum for which we have planned to conduct tuitions remotely using Skype given by volunteers from other cities. We will have to provide High Speed internet connection for this. For class room training, we are in need of a projector. Mr. Gandhi Srinivasan has agreed to contribute Rs.30000 for the projector.

Support needed:

We are in need of Rs. 93,000 additionally for the computer room setup. We are planning to finish this project by the end of this month and will start the computer classes from first week of July. Request you to extend your support as before for the computer room setup as well.

Admissions:

52 new students have joined mostly studying VI STD. Vacancy is still there for admitting SC Students. Some may join in the course of the month and the total figure shall come around 150 to 160.

Dedication Event in July 2015:

The Dedication event is being planned for 2nd week of July 2015. We will be happy to have all the well wishers and donors to be there showing their love and care for the students &Sevalayam as but for them, nothing is possible - **Arunmozhi, Coordinator, Sevalayam, Madurai**



- Volunteers to stand at every cross road and guide the people.


- Detailed programs on 9th July 2015



From May 15th onwards we were having summer vacation. Then I felt bore without college. At that right time founder called me and he gave an idea how to utilize the time in holidays. Thus, I was so pleased to experience his graceful concern, unconditional caring & loving affection towards me. Then I started attending classes in the summer course, especially for the students, who completed their degree, inter etc. and pursuing for various competitive exams and they all are from different places. There I have learnt different topics regarding reasoning classes, etc., which was interesting. During this wonderful, divine

coaching, I got an idea that , "why can't I teach the self-defense techniques, that I got trained in a program to these innocent village girls". So by the blessings of lord, one fine day I started my service in making all the girl students to learn all the techniques, like anti-kidnapping, anti-rape drill etc., thus wonderfully enjoyed. Apart from these, I spared some time for my study purpose.

For the few days I have spent my vacation in Kurnool at home. One day casually I went for a eye checkup which I yearly use to visit. Then he told that my optic nerve has got inflamed in my both eyes. So he advised me to undergo some tests like colour vision, fields (FHA) test for conformation. After seeing results he reported that there was complete blur around the nerve in my right eye when compared to left eye. In order to know whether it is peripheral gliosis, or problem in disc and the etiology, he asked me to undergo MRI scan. It costs more than Rs.5000/- in private scanning centres.so I preferred general hospital in Kurnool, because it is not there even in our hospital. After getting signed on different papers by neuro doctor, I went to technician & he asked me to come after 4 days. So as per the given date I went to hospital. Finally the other technician told that it is impossible to scan my brain & orbits due to the presence of metallic braces to my teeth. He gave a trial but there was no problem like dragging force on my teeth even though the scan is mainly based on magnetic resonance. However it became impossible to make out an image due to the failure of penetration of radio frequencies. Again doctor suggested me to go for CT scan. Right now am not having any problem in my vision except severe headache now and then. Am quiet all right. From 1st of June onwards our classes commenced again. Now I have been posted to TB ward where am staying so much cautious by using masks, while examining the patients & clearly knowing about respiratory system.

GVK School Update



Vivekananda Degree College to come under abhaya umbrella

It was during 2006, Vivekananda Degree College was started at Vempalli by my nephew, Mr.P. Muralinatha Reddy after working in Indian Navy for about 15 years, and he has started working with Merchant Navy now. Out of his savings he wanted to contribute a little to the society through this small project. This is the only degree college at Vempally, which is 45 KMS from Cuddapah on the way to Pullivendula. The college offers B.Sc., B.Com, and B.A.

During 2007, Intermediate course (10+2) with MPC & CEC subjects was started and admissions to Junior Inter were not made in 2013-14, since we have decided to close the Intermediate Course. The Total number of students during the past academic year 2014-15 was 130. Out of which 75% are girls. The students attend the college from around 30 villages around Vempally.

The college is being run under the name of "Vivekananda Education Society". The society purchased the land, 4 acres and 80 cents from Government of Andhra Pradesh on a hillock. Temporary sheds were constructed and the college was shifted from rental premises to the present location during 2010.


The teaching staff working in the institution are 15 in number including three women teachers, whose monthly salary ranges from INR 6500.00 to INR 12000.00. Supporting staff for the institution are 4 in number whose monthly salary ranges from INR 6000.00 to INR 8000.00.

The Institution has Computer, Physics and Chemistry Labs apart from Library with minimum number of books. We are looking for a Librarian and Physical Trainer teacher. The institution does not have any liabilities as of now. And the entire financial support is from Mr. P. Muralinatha Reddy who has spent about INR 60 Lakhs for running the institution till now. The college was started with a Mission to Serve with no

commercial gain. We wish to train the students to become good human beings stressing more on academics and character building equally.

Our resources will not match with our vision, hence we are

looking for a spiritual, service oriented organization which can take over the college. We would like to donate the college with only condition being to serve the educational needs without any commercial motto. other source of income. We appeal well wishers to come forward and help him to settle in life with the auto KSV Siva Krishna, Secretary, abhaya


