Please submit a Project Proposal of **no more than** 2,500 words using the following guidelines as your section headings. You may submit the project budget as a separate sheet.

- A clear detailed description of the Project, including particular outputs or products the Project will generate, any arguments and ideas the Project will put forth, and the need for the Project;
- An explanation of how the Project builds on existing efforts or charts new terrain;
- A description of the Project's expected impact and how you might measure it;
- A detailed account of how you will achieve your goals, including a communications and/or outreach strategy. Please describe the specific audiences you hope to reach, your reasons for focusing on them, and how you intend to influence them;
- The reasons you are especially suited to carry out this Project
- A description of how you expect the Project to fit into your career trajectory and future work;
- A Project timeline
- An explanation of how you might engage with OSI during your Fellowship. Please specify how these interactions could add value to your Project;
- Estimated Project expenses (not including living stipend) including travel for Project, conference fees, and any other necessary coverage (health insurance, research assistance, subscriptions that are relevant to your project/i.e. for technical-based components of your project)
